- **Preserving the cultural heritage** which is considered one of the important elements in the formation of the Palestinian cultural and national identity.
- **Depicting the old** Palestinian dress, displaying the holdings of the Palestinian farmer, representing the religious life, such as: the Prophet's birthday party, weddings .. Etc.
- Place and its sanctity: representing the place is part of the means of defending the identity of the Palestinians by re-imaging the relationship between the Palestinian and his home on the one hand, and the Palestinian and his village on the other hand; the house is the spatial space that symbolizes survival and existence. (village, cities, Bedouin and refugee camps).
- Occupation practices: and confiscation, violence against innocents, prisoner, separation (Palestine is a story in which the artist narrates visual scenes that express the pain of that reality)

















ABED ABDI REFUGEES 1, 1967 WOODCUT ON PAPER 45 X 61 CM






ABED ABDI UNDER SIEGE, 1967 WOODCUT ON PAPER 44 X 66 CM











Revolution was the beginning, 2016, Sliman Mansour


