Phase One

Project Planning and Use cases

You should work as a group of three, for the project you have submit the problem statements.

You will need to submit the following:

Your group should use the scenario-based approach to elicit the requirements. A written statement describing what each member of your group contributed to this project is needed. Your group is required to develop a complete set of use cases that describe the system.

The task should be word processed and organised according to the following points:

Question 1:

System description: system name and brief description (be specific) what are the purpose and the objectives from developing the system?

Identify the system Actors and provide a brief description of each actor role.

Question 2:

Each group member should chose one use case and provide three usage scenario; one normal usage, one have an alternative option and one with exception (error), one of those scenarios you should collaborate with a colleagues of you in the class. So you need to tell him/her about the system and s/he should provide you with the details.

Question 3: Use case diagram:

Draw a use case model. The model should include the actors, the use cases, the relation between the use cases and the actors and the relation between the use cases.

Question 4: Use case specification:

Write a Use Case specification, each group member should write two use cases; one of them is based on the scenario written in the above question. The use case specification should contain the following sections:

- Use case name
- Brief description
- Actors
- Preconditions (Entry Conditions)
- Main flow

- Alternative flows
- Exception flows
- Special Requirements
- Post-conditions (Exit Conditions)
