Introduction

* The future offers many challenges and opportunities for dietitians. Food and nutrition are

gaining prime importance in the issues of health and wellness at no time in the past as there

been so much interest in nutrition and food science. Dietetic professionals must "seize the

moment" be ready to embrace the changes and challenges of the future.

Challenges include:

1. Changing demographics

The Aging Population: The rapidly increasing number of the elderly will shift the focus of health services from acute to chronic care.

Ethnic Diversity: More diverse populations (consider food, culture, and language)

Accessibility to healthcare: Growing poverty among some populations and high healthcare costs may reduce accessibility to healthcare. (See next slide for Palestinian statistics)

Mobility: Increased moving into workforce and relocating of extended families. (See next slides for Palestinian statistics)
