## Instruction Formats Problems

## Problem 1

Suppose a datapath has three operand busses (two source, one destination), 45 instruction types, and 32 registers where each register is 16 bits wide. Immediate operands can be in the range of $\pm 128 \mathrm{~K}$.
Design an instruction format for instructions that have one operation, one destination register and two source registers. Label the fields and minimum number of bits need for each field.
